The Parking lot will be closed this Sunday and Monday (7/27 - 7/28) for cleaning and sealing.




Planning Commission

At 6:00 p.m., on the first Monday of every month, the Planning Commission meets to guide growth and determine land use. At the next meeting, they will discuss an application to rezone the field on the right as you drive into town from Business to Residential. Be sure you are part of the process.



New Entry Sign

You may notice some minor construction work at the town's entrance. This entry sign is based on the concept drawing of the selected sign from the Town Plan, as approved by the Town Council.

The Onancock Tree Board designed a more interactive, colorful, and useful Town Square. You will see irrigation installed, along with the first four new streetlights, followed by new grass, and then the new plantings (when it is the best time to plant for their success).



Quick Q&A

Q: Is mosquito spraying still happening?
A: Yes. Twice each week, in the very early morning, the town sprays for mosquitoes. We make every effort to respect the people who have called or posted a sign requesting that we skip their property.

Q: Is there really only 3-hour parking allowed downtown?

A: Yes. This was a long decision made by the

Planning Commission and the Town Council. The reason is to keep spaces open in front of downtown businesses. Employees and residents are encouraged to park in the lot behind Town Hall or the Queen Street lot.

Q: When are the water meters getting replaced?
A: Within the next month, you will begin to receive communications from HRSD about the upcoming work. We will closely monitor this project and communicate as frequently as necessary to ensure a smooth transition. There will be disruption in service, and we will share specific with you as quickly as know. Please note that after the water meters are replaced, we will switch to monthly billing.
